- b Museum** check the RHS dark red post of the rear double gate, up high.
- c 36 Hutton St** driveway exit, near the rear of the property. Old Maris Brothers school.
- d Bluestone Theatre** tree dangle, behind the fence, far right corner.
- e Courthouse** walk on the grass along the neighbour's wall, past the AC unit.
- f Ruby Café** on the neighbour's wall, in the alfresco garden, behind the fence.
- g Library** at the door, near the playground. Cross to the other side at the traffic light.
- h Op Shop** high up near the front door.
- i The Old Auction House**

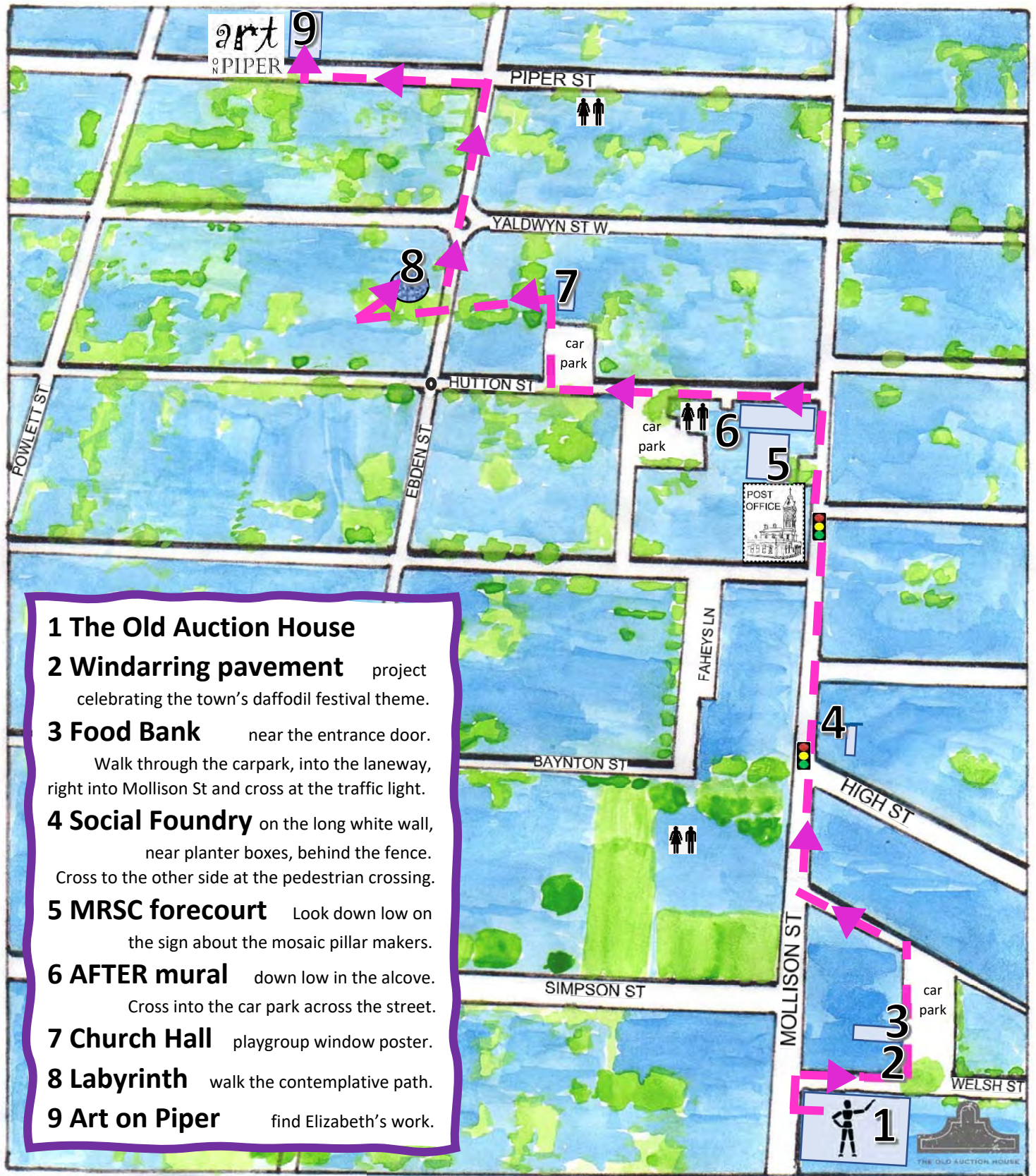

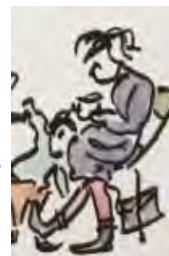


- 1 The Old Auction House**
- 2 Windarring pavement** project celebrating the town's daffodil festival theme.
- 3 Food Bank** near the entrance door. Walk through the carpark, into the laneway, right into Mollison St and cross at the traffic light.
- 4 Social Foundry** on the long white wall, near planter boxes, behind the fence. Cross to the other side at the pedestrian crossing.
- 5 MRSC forecourt** Look down low on the sign about the mosaic pillar makers.
- 6 AFTER mural** down low in the alcove. Cross into the car park across the street.
- 7 Church Hall** playgroup window poster.
- 8 Labyrinth** walk the contemplative path.
- 9 Art on Piper** find Elizabeth's work.
